



MS. MARIÑELARENA 5TH GRADE SCIENCE

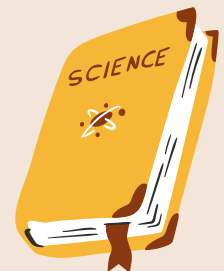


Dear Guardian,
